

## St. John the Baptist Master Plan, Town Hall meeting July 26, 2014

Plans show only one way to property off Carolina Trace, will there be another entry?

In phase one there will be only on principle entrance into the property, will have other entrances when school is built.

Will the school be handicap accessible?

Yes.

Where will the additional 400 seats come from when the church is expanded?

The gathering space will be converted for the additional seating.

Will we have a flag pole at our new church?

Yes, and it will be in a prominent place.

Will the capital campaign done by the archdiocese replace the separate collection we now have throughout the year?

They have not said at this time.

Where will the tabernacle be?

It has not be decided at this time but will probably be in the center or to the side of the altar.

Will there be a place for the bride to dress off the gathering space?

Yes, on the plans there is a meeting room shown that can be used at weddings and funerals.

Will the altar by handicapped accessible?

Yes, there will be a ramp on the side of the altar.

How many feet will it be from the handicapped parking spaces to the church?

Don't know at this time but we will follow all regulations.

What will be the route for the funeral procession?

The plan is to use the plaza in front of the gathering space or the covered drop off area if it is bad weather.

Will there be steps?

No

Is there going to be a cry room?

Not as a designate space, the gathering area space will be used in phase one. When the offices and meeting rooms are added it could be in the nursery.

Master plan shows 2016 for completion of the church, when will the mass schedule change?

Once the new church is completed the mass schedule will be changed.

How much money do we need before we can start to build?

50% must be in the bank and the balance must be pledged.

What would it cost to add the second gathering space into the first phase?

Approximate cost would be \$2,000,000

Where is the organ and choir going to be?

It will be off to the side in the front of church.

Will we be able to make separate contributions to the church and the archdiocese?

It is two separate campaigns with a set amount for each.

We have a set amount due; do we get 60% back if we go over the reduced amount?

We have no answer on that at this time.

Are restrooms and temporary space for a cry room in phase one?

We will have restrooms in phase one and cry area will be in the gathering space.

Will the stained glass windows go?

Yes, this is a way of connecting the past and the future.

Where is the rectory going to be?

When the time comes the plan is to purchase a home on either Carolina Trace or New Haven Road.

What will happen to the current property?

It will be put up for sale after all facilities are moved to the new location.

What will happen to the funds from the sale of the property?

They will go back to St. John's.

There are no costs shown on the hand out.

This will be available on the web site. The total presentation will be put on the church web site.

Will we be able to use the gathering space for visitation before a funeral?

Yes, in the first phase and in the final phase.

What would it cost to add the bell tower to the first phase?

Don't know at this time.

Does the cost include lighting for street and parking?

Yes

Could we use the entrance to Barney Drive that currently dead ends into our property?

Yes, it has been looked into as a possible exit in the future.

Does property need to be re-zoned?

No, zoning does not have to be changed.

Where is the street entrance to the church?

Currently we have a 40 foot entrance off Carolina Trace that will be widened.

Will there be more than one entry to the parish hall?

One main entrance at this time is shown on the master plan but that can be changed at a later time when construction is started on hall.

Is the land in the township or city?

Land is in the Harrison city limits.

Will the sacristy be heated and air conditioned?

Yes
